

## **INTEGRATED PLANNING**

Joint planning exercise that ensures participation of all stakeholders and affected departments. Its objective is to examine all economic, social, and environmental costs and benefits, in order to determine most appropriate option and to plan a suitable course of action.

### **What's involved in integrated planning?**

To achieve integration, we need to consider a range of factors for both current and future demand, including:

- Interaction of the transport network and land use
- Performance of the transport system
- Affordability
- Urban design
- Demand management
- Accessibility
- Safety
- Network management
- Key stakeholders involved in planning, operating and using of transportation networks
- Different modes of transport, eg cars, trucks, buses, rail, etc.

### **OBJECTIVES OF INTEGRATED PLANNING**

- *To review and develop policies to support the best possible use of the land and the sustainable management of land resources.*
- *To improve and strengthen planning, management and evaluation systems for land and land resources.*
- *To strengthen institutions and coordinating mechanisms for land and land resources.*
- *To create mechanisms which will ensure the active involvement and participation of all concerned (the stakeholders).*
